1. Approval of minutes from previous meeting

2. Feed Leeds Current projects:

<u>Sub groups</u> (sub-groups are made up of selected FL committee members, others from within the wider advisory group, and fully external experts).

Sow a Row Xtra, LVL and Hedge Veg – Becky

Successful sub group meeting discussed opportunities to promote Sow X and LVL.

- Agreed Emmas flyer and social media promotion was great and we should do more of this to help spread the word! Especially around key dates such as National Gardening Week would Also discussed
- 2. Also need to simplify to make it more clear to the public where they can drop off/collect seedlings.

Penny mentioned that Horsforth has 2 events coming up that SowX could contribute to:

- Launch of Climate ACTION Horsforth 15th May. FL banner etc to be located and passed on so Sonja and SJ can attend.
 - ACTION Sonja and SJ to attend to promote SowX and will borrow Beckys tea trolley to create a mobile veg library for the event, with seedling give away ACTION Sonja and Adam to consider if we have budget for a flyer/postcard we can give out at events
- Art of Going Green 11am-5pm on 2nd/3rd July at St Margarets

• LESSN - Rosie A and Sonja

Rosie keen to ensure shorter event is ready and that enough teachers are involved. Sonja shared similar concerns and will clarify that resources are being used properly. Agreed to set up LESSN meeting separately and will report back

Composting Group – Sonja

It was agreed that the Leeds Rotters will continue with the website and facebook managed by Paul M and contributed to by FL committee. It was agreed that Rotters is aimed at individuals rather than composting groups, the focus of Emmas funded programme is to create community composting at a number of locations across the city so would need its own brand identity.

Note that Zero Waste Leeds can support compost initiatives and LCC offer <u>discounts</u> on <u>compost bins</u>.

Orchard Group - Sonja

Gini and Alan on top of things and working with the council to develop new orchards. Also lots of great workshops offered by <u>fruitworks</u> on their website

IE Garforth – Dan (emailed update)

Big Incredible Edible BBQ held at Garforth with IE groups from across Leeds - was a nice return to normality! The Community Composting pilot is going well (but Emma can update on that) whilst we are working with another area of Leeds to potentially get another IE project up and running.

For the wider network, we had a national Incredible Edible meeting last week and Dan was at the House of Lords launching the "Right to Grow" campaign.

From a Garforth perspective, we launched another new bed, are supporting Eco-Friendly Garforth with a food waste initiative throughout May and also supporting a couple of schools with their growing areas.

• IE Crossgates – Rachael

New beds being installed at Skyliner and within Temple Newsam Walled Garden – both highly visible locations with good foot fall, great opportunity to promote GYO and healthy eating.

The Seacroft Climate Action hub have also been provided with materials to grow potatoes in a bag

Foodwise - Sonja

To celebrate Earth Day on 22nd April, Foodwise planted an apple tree at the Old Fire Station. The tree was grafted by them as at Fruitworks workshop.

The Food Strategy is moving forward well and Ellie and Sonja are working towards a consultation and a draft of the sustainability section.

Rosie A has moved fig tree to Burley park and lots of seeds have been planted

• Leeds Allotments Federation - Rosie H

Congratulations to the group who attended Harrogate Flower Show with their allotment garden, which was awarded Best Show Garden.

Rosie has also been promoting SowX at events with allotments and would welcome some flyers to give out. Rosie has also met up with Ann F re land access/hedge veg and allotment surplus and Ann is keen to support her work.

• Horsforth Community Garden - Penny

Council waiting for them to get funding before they give go ahead. No joy with applications so far.

Climate Action Horsforth is one of the Leeds hubs – the open day (15th May, see above) forms part of that and is key to finding out what the community wants.

It was noted that Kay is brilliant, and a paid worker for the Horsforth hub.

Penny mentioned community café in Horsforth has been using surplus from local allotments and had 1 bed dedicated to producing for them. SW asked if possible to use events to capture details of allotments to connect with local orgs

ACTION RH agreed and has contacts already so can map this out

AO reported that a 6month <u>traineeship</u> and also a community grower (link to be added when located) role are due to be advertised any day now.

 ACTION: RF to make it shared document on Google so it can be edited
