Minutes of previous meeting

1. Feed Leeds Current projects

Get Growing Leeds (inc LVL and Sow a Row Xtra) – review of campaign and events supported

Feed Leeds were successfully awarded funding from Leeds Community Foundation to launch the #GetGrowingLeeds project for 2024 and we are now collating the results/impacts of the engagement. We used the funding to engage new growers across the city by promoting events held between 24/5 and 9/6/24 and sharing free plug plants with groups. We thank Zoe Parker, Foodwise for developing the social media campaign and marketing materials.

In total we were able to support 20 events organised by different groups across the city and are collating. We need to follow up the groups to ask for data on numbers attending.

ACTION: Sarah-Jane email all groups who registered to check on numbers of attendees, plants given away and engagement/images from events.

ACTION: Sonja Complete the video of Feed Leeds engagement at the Bedford Fields event.

FUTURE PLANS – We will be holding a harvest celebration inviting all the groups to meet and share a meal and good news stories. This event will be a good way to evaluate the impact of the campaigns and share best practice between groups.

ACTION: LVL Subgroup Begin planning a harvest event in October, inc venue and date. Becky will demonstrate seasonal cooking, what other activities would we like to include.

Farm Group

The Farm Group and NRFC have been successful in their funding bid to Farming the Future, for a project to explore a bean processing unit in the North for agro-ecological farmers, aiming to supply beans/pulses for human consumption regionally.
